- III. President's Report
  - K-2 curriculum supplements
    - i. Shift to science of reading/phonics in reading, have some needs
      - Need- teachers having access to high quality decodables to use in the classroom
        - \$18,860 for decodables for instruction- fiction and non-fiction texts for each classroom, 6 copies of each title + ELL teacher + Special Education teachers for pull-out students
        - b. In class libraries- K & 1st decodable libraries for students to read independently- \$5,333.49
        - c. Dropping Knowledge- Heidi- Martin Literacy
        - d. Grand total- \$24,193.49
          - i. Scholastic and Amazon links, cover changes- Motion for \$25,500- Approved
  - Positivity Project- SEL Curriculum 5th-8th Grade
    - i. Getting kids to stop and think about scenarios in a positive manner
    - ii. Rolled out Week 0 with the teachers
    - iii. Corey is the implementation specialist for the school, receiving training and able to train
    - iv. Cost \$3,795 annually, may be able to move into the school budget in the future

    - Coaches Stipends
      - i. OST Funding came through, \$4,000 short this year (\$22,000- covers Robotics, sports, etc.), ask for now would be to continue to cover the parent stipends. Currently \$1,000 for a Football stipend- motion to approve- Approved
  - Novels: Here is the link

- i. Through Josh \$12, if NPTO orders would be \$8, 7th & 8th graders will get to hear the author speak (8th graders heard her last year)
- ii. Weaving into the Civics curriculum, tells the story on the Road to Freedom (author was the youngest person on it)

  - i. Thank you to NPTO for sending Josh
  - ii. PD this summer helped reignite belonging, will notice in the Sentinel updates
- Therapy Dogs sponsorship level
  - i. All set up for once a month, 8x over the year
  - ii. Every kid will get to see them
  - iii. Become a sponsor- \$500- motion to approve- Approved
- 2 Nettelhorst positions, bill will be coming, likely around \$193,000, similar to past few years
- S. Dilla Thomas school visit- Chicago Hip Hop historian, has his own bus, all staff will get to go, Bronzeville trip- \$2,500, but Josh will cover from his budget
- Playground update
  - i. Josh, Mags, Kelly, and Anne Dodge met with the district
    - 2 phases, back playlot is phase 1, front playlot is phase 2
    - \$1.3M already allocated, through monies from Alderman Lawson & Senator Feigenholtz (\$500,000 is tied up for 18-24 months, leaving \$800,000 available for phase 1)
    - CPS will bring some money to the table, need to know how much from CPS
    - Last estimate was \$2M, Josh will have an update next week
    - Josh has a breakfast with Tom Ricketts and Cubs charities this month,
       Mags to speak with Blackhawks charities
    - Suggested donation from Haunted House fundraiser, possibility
    - CPS engineers still need to look at the designs, Paul suggests the idea of selling bricks to businesses and families
- Support SEED- pay for first dinner in October
  - i. Mr. Lopez reached out to Mags, potluck for their monthly meetings, asking for NPTO to cover the first dinner, less than \$500.
- NPTO mixer
  - i. Reaching out to a local spot to ask them to host so we can find volunteers/recruit
  - ii. Get to know your NPTO
- Curriculum night- slide deck/presentation- September 18
- Festival or the Arts- Beer tent/ sticker contest update
  - i. Beer tent is all set

- Movie Night in the Back Lot

  - ii. The plan would be as follows:
