- III. President's Report

- VI. Community Events
 - Open Gym for 4th-8th grade recap. Hosted last weekend 15-20 kids. 4th graders came for soccer and 6th graders for volleyball. It was a drop off and the parents loved that. Went really well.
 - Makers Market on March 9th 1-4pm. Currently have 25 tables assigned for 34 students! Registration closes on Sunday, Feb 16th. Will need to figure out how to find about 22 tables to use. Will also need some additional day of event support. There are closer to 36-38 kids. 5 people said bring their own tables. Need 25 tables. Use a little big of everything. Can't do the auditorium, do the lunchroom and hallway. Put tables in lunchroom to the side. Can use as merchant table. 4 people want to use electricity crepes on demand. Lots of food, hot chocolate. How to advertise. Inviting in 44th ward newsletter to get out of folks come. Dodgeball the entire day, so maybe we can get those parents. Registration

closes on Sunday and steady every day. No boost. Need additional day of support. Outlets are a consideration. Foodmaking preferred in cafetaria. Will draw out and give table assignments.
